This week our testing team shared a positive example of an emergency department referrer taking part in the routes in test, which had a good outcome for the child and family.

"We were able to consider together the information, jointly agree on safe next steps and both the referrer and the test social worker felt this conversation came to the best outcome for the child".

Contacting the front door

Through reviews it has been identified that several referrers are currently calling the test telephone number for advice, or to be asked to be passed on to a Social Worker. While the Social Workers on the test pod are managing these calls, they risk clogging the telephone line that isn't intended for this type of call.

We therefore remind you that the telephone number **0115 804 0003** is for professional referrers in **Bassetlaw** and **Newark and Sherwood only** to refer safeguarding concerns.

- Referrers from all other areas, are reminded to please contact the MASH as normal on 0300 500 80
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- Referrers requiring advice before making a referral to the MASH are asked to contact the Consultation Line on 0115 977 4247

The Advisors may invite referrers to attend a multi-agency conversation if they feel a multi-agency approach would be beneficial.

MASH Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT)

The MASH Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) meetings were recently relaunched and have worked really well, helping families to get the right support at the right time. The meetings take place on Tuesday and Thursday and include representatives from Children's Social Care, Police, Health, Education, Early Help and Youth Justice, discussing up to 3 families that have been referred to the MASH. In the meeting partners share the pertinent information they hold, summarise the needs, risks and strengths for the family, then agree the most appropriate support for the child and family.

The MDT working group helped to steer the relaunch and iron out the practical challenges, and will meet to review progress soon, feeding into the wider review of the Big Test.
