

Child Sexual Exploitation Briefing Operation Striver

Definition

"involves children and young people receiving something - for example, accommodation, drugs, gifts or affection - as a *result of them performing sexual activities, or having others perform sexual activities on them. It can occur without physical contact, when children are groomed to post sexual images of* themselves on the internet."

(DfE CSE Action Plan Pg4)

Remember: there are also links between runaways (children that go missing) and child sexual exploitation

Aims of Operation Striver

- To establish a network of multi-agency professionals who can share low level, non-emergency intelligence/information with the police.
- ► To build on the work established in Nottingham City.
- Police to share appropriate intelligence with agencies.
- For intelligence to be used to disrupt activities, develop a 'problem profile' and determine policing priorities.
- ► To ensure a proportionate response to the intelligence.

What information can be shared?

- ► Locations
- Fast Food Premises
- Hotels/Guest Houses
- Addresses; specific
- Areas
- Vehicles
- Make/model
- Vehicle Registration Mark
- Contact Details
- Mobile
- e mail

- ► People
- Names/Nicknames
- Persons who could present a risk to children
- Concerning Behaviour
- Day time/Evenings
- Dress
- Alcohol/Drug Usage

Making a Submission – Operation Striver

- Form used is for intelligence sharing for low level non-emergency information.
- Completed and submitted if you have information concerning people, places, activities, or vehicles which you believe may be involved with, or connected to CSE.
- Completed and submitted if you have concerns regarding a young person at risk of child sexual exploitation.

NB: This is not a referral form and should not replace usual practice of referring to social care, SEIU or CAIU.

- Anything of immediate risk should be reported via 999 or 101 to the police control room.
- ▶ Police in box is monitored 24/7.

The information contained within will be shared with Nottinghamshire Police to:

- Develop disruption strategies to be implemented by a multi-agency panel.
- Collate intelligence concerned with children and young people exposed to or at risk of CSE.
- Inform current/future investigations concerning the sexual exploitation of children and young people.

Nottinghamshire County Model

- Operation Striver form disseminated widely across County agencies.
- Bi-monthly concerns network meeting led by Children's Social Care and the Police.

Initial membership:

- Children's Social Care
- Police
- District/Borough Councils
- Health
- Targeted Support Service
- Youth Services

Other professionals ton join as appropriate.

What it isn't

- ► A quick fix.
- A replacement for referring individual children to the appropriate agencies.
- There won't necessarily be feedback from shared intelligence.
